

LIGHT OPERA SCONCE



The Light Opera sconce stands alone or as a companion to the Light Opera chandelier and equally at home in a traditional or modern environment. It is constructed on a light gauge steel wire frame often used in creating garden topiary forms. Beaded chains and smooth beaded glass are draped over the frame.

The exposed electrical wire becomes a part of the loose design. Frosted rose petal glass shades, from France by Vianne, provide a soft and ample light source. Available in either a one or two light design.
